

Useful Tips

Being well prepared for your vacations is an essential element for anxious-free holidays. Below you will find some useful tips that our experienced team would like to point out.

- In order to minimize the waiting hour at our office, send us the crew list & skipper certificates two weeks prior to the embarkation. Your arrival time is of great importance to us, since a specific appoitment will be arranged for you.
- Plan ahead, book your transfer from the airport to our base. A private car will pick you up from the spot and drop you off at our office.
- 3 If you have light luggage to be stored, inform our team to secure a place. Soft luggage is always preferable on yachts.
- 4 During the sailing period, in case of an emergency, contact our fleet manager or base manager as soon as possible. Safety is always our first priority. Our technical team will reach out to you at no time.
- 5 For bareboat charters, in case of an incident, having insured your security deposit is always a safe pillow.
- 6 The last day before your charter ends, we will be waiting for you until 16:00 at our pontoon, where we will also assist you with the refueling of the yacht.
- 7 Do not forget to be in your best summer mood, relax and have fun. Ahoy!

Antipaxos

Its olive groves in harmony with its large vineyard and the chalk white coast attribute to Antipaxoi the unique beauty of an unspoilt paradise.

Atokos

Corfu

The amazing island of Corfu is located in the western side of the Ionian Sea. Although Corfu is not that close to the section where most of the Ionian Islands are located, it is one of the most accessible ports of Greece!

Ithaca

Modern Ithaca is generally identified with Homer's Ithaca, the home of Odysseus, whose delayed return to the island is the plot of the classical Greek tale the Odyssey.



Kastos

Kastos is a low-lying, long and narrow little island covered in olive trees and at which dozens of boats sailing over the Ionian Sea moor safely each day.



Kalamos

Kalamos is the largest of a fringe of small islands located in the region of Lefkada, surrounded by the boundless blue of the sea.

Meganisi
